Depending on personal interest and background, this can be country- and route-related research on routes, infrastructure, etc., creating and organizing route-stages, data processing, coordination with local cooperation partners or support in coordination with the other project dimensions.

**What do we offer:**

- Opportunity to learn new soft and hard skills (GPS, map creation, route planning, etc.)

- Prospect of long-term collaboration in the project
- New contacts and networks for future collaborations
- Confirmation of whether you are working in a legally recognized non-profit association (e.g. in the form of receipt of an internship confirmation or a job reference)

**The following points would be advantageous (or the motivation for learning it):**

- Experience working in interdisciplinary teams
- Longer-term commitment and interest from June 2022 to hiking a bit yourself if possible
- Different language skills are an advantage
- Conscientious and precise handling of data and its processing
- Route planning experience
- Technical (basic) knowledge in dealing with analogue and digital maps, Excel, route planning tools (Komoot, google maps, openstreetmap, ...)
- (Long distance) hiking experience
- Expertise and experience in different regions and countries

**Areas of responsibility (depending on interests and division within the team):**

- Research activities (comparison of routes (sections) with existing routes of the project or separate long-distance hiking trails, research for alternative routes, infrastructure, elevation profiles, ...)
- Route planning based on research activities or existing routes
- Coordination with other project dimensions (research, education, media/art, outreach/social media)
- Coordination with (existing) European cooperation partners
